- **Field locations can be found on-line.** Visit [www.ayso190.org](http://www.ayso190.org) and click on the "Fields" button on the left side of the page.
- The winning team coach (or home team coach in case of a tie) must report the score on-line within 24 hours of game completion. Visit [www.ayso190.org](http://www.ayso190.org) and click on the "Submit A Score" button on the left side of the page. Note: this does not apply to U6 teams.
- The Home team is first team listed in each pairing. They choose which side of the field they will sit on, and the other team sits on the opposite side of the field (where allowed). The Home team is also responsible for providing a referee for the game in the absence of an assigned neutral referee. However, any certified referee always takes priority over a non-certified volunteer.
- All rescheduled games need to be approved by Regional 190. If a reschedule is required, both coaches should contact the Regional Coach Administrator and request a new date, time, and field location.
- All Region 190 games are canceled if a tornado watch or warning is in effect for Macomb County within 30 minutes prior to game time. In all other cases, games can only be cancelled at the field at game time - all players must report to the field.
- All participants in AYSO are volunteers (coaches, referees, board members). To volunteer, contact any Board member.
- Referees do the best that they can. Calls made by the referee are final. If you can do better, please volunteer!
